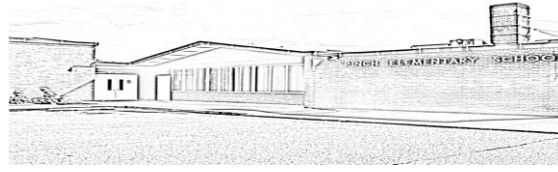

KINDERGARTEN ROUND-UP

Kindergarten Round-up is scheduled for March 22, 2018. *Parents will need to register for a time to enroll students on that day. Packets will also be available to pick up prior to registration. We will begin taking registration times on February 22, 2018.*

To help with the registration of your child for Kindergarten next year you will need to bring the following information:

- Immunization record
- Certified birth certificate from the state of birth with a raised seal
- Your street address with proof of residency for that address, such as a utility bill, rental contract, etc..., that will show your name and that address
- Other information that you will need is telephone numbers for you (home, cell, work), and two persons who will be responsible for your child if you cannot be reached; physicians name and telephone, dentist name and telephone number; name and numbers of medical insurance; current health issues; health history; medications, allergies; and restrictions, if any.
